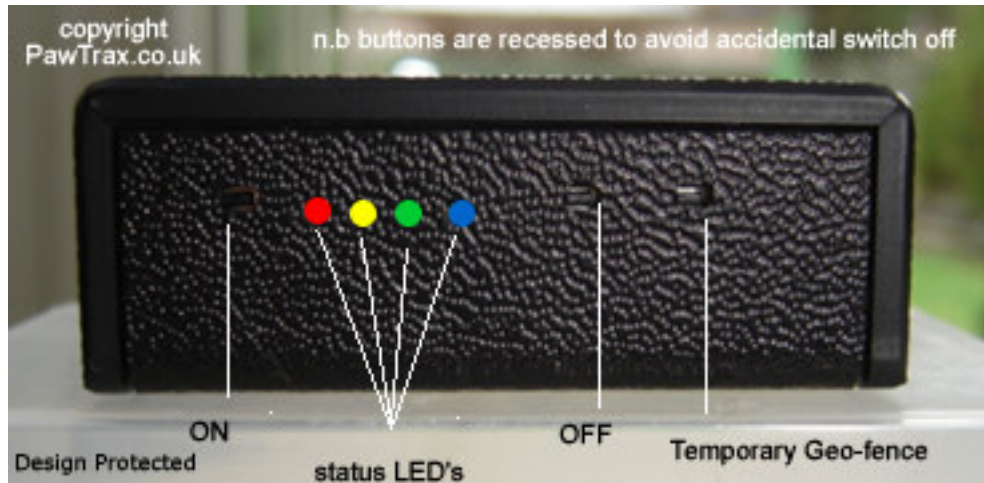
## **Quick Start Guide**

Thank you for purchasing The-PAT.

The-PAT uses GSM/GPRS and GPS technology enabling you to FIND, TRACK and SECURE your pet 24/7/365.

This quick start guide will get you up and running with the basic locate functions.



### Obtaining a position using sms

Press the ON button with a pen/pencil  
Wait for the red light to flash slowly  
Place The-PAT outside where it can obtain a GPS fix  
Wait for the green light to flash  
Send W to The-PAT as an sms

You receive the location by coordinates.

After receiving the coordinates, manually input them into Google Maps ([www.maps.google.com](http://www.maps.google.com)) or the PawTrax website at [free.pawtrax.co.uk](http://free.pawtrax.co.uk) or Google mobile maps on your web/wap enabled mobile phone.

**Note:** The coordinates will be received in the following format N, Lat: 2233.0361, E, Lon: 11404.9644, but when you input them you should use this format N22 33.0361, E114 04.9644 – There is a space between N22 and 33.0361 etc



## Obtaining a position using GPRS via the PawTrax mapping platform

Press the ON button with a pen/pencil  
Wait for the red light to flash slowly  
Place The-PAT outside where it can obtain a GPS fix  
Wait for the green light to flash


Go to <http://locate.pawtrax.co.uk>

Login using your username and password



Send the following sms to The-PAT to turn on GPRS.

S,GPRSON



Select the Monitoring option



Within a minute or so you will see The-PAT's location on the map updating every minute

When you have finished tracking turn off GPRS by sending the following sms

S,GPRSOFF
